Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of tourist spots under the administrative control of Ministry of Tourism in the State of Haryana at present;
- (b) whether all the spots are connected with national highways; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the amount spent on them during each of the last three years?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

(a) to (c): Development and Promotion of Tourism is primarily undertaken by the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. Ministry of Tourism provides Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for tourism projects which are prioritized in consultation with the State Governments/Union Territories. The projects which are in accordance with the scheme guidelines are sanctioned/funds released subject to continuation of Scheme, availability of funds and submission of Utilization Certificates for funds released to them in the previous years.

The Ministry of Tourism has no administrative control on tourist spots of the country including those in the State of Haryana. However, Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned total CFA of Rs.1608.91 lakh for development of tourism infrastructure to the State Government of Haryana in last three years, which is at annexure.
