- (a) and (b): Ministry of Tourism has launched Campaign Clean India in 2012-13 to sensitize all sections of society on the importance of cleanliness and hygiene and to ensure an acceptable level of cleanliness and hygiene practices at tourist destinations. The campaign is a blend of persuasion, education, training and demo- nstration. A list of the monuments/tourist destinations identified under this Campaign is attached.
- (c): No funds have been allocated by the Government for this campaign. The campaign is sustained through involvement of private and public sector stakeholders as part of their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR).
- (d): There are no instances of complaints brought to the notice of this Ministry by foreign tourists against cleanliness at major tourist destinations.
