- (a) whether the Railways have any proposal for the infrastructure development of Kannur Railway Station in the State of Kerala;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which it is likely to be implemented?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a) to (c): Development of stations is a continuous process. Kannur station has been provided with passenger amenities commensurate with the passenger traffic and category of station. The station has been developed under various schemes of modernisation of stations. In the last three years, works for provision of water hydrants on platform No.3, galvalume sheet platform shelter, construction of booking office at second entry, improvement to VIP lounge, platforms' surface and paving of car parking area, etc. at an approx. cost of Rs.2.0 crore have been completed. In addition, work for facelift of station building and improvements to circulating area at a cost of Rs.4.7 crore has been undertaken for completion during the current financial year.
