MEDICAL FACILITIES AT RAILWAY STATIONS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways have any plan for setting up medical rooms for handling emergency situations relating to railway accident victims at railway stations in the country including Surat Railway Station;
- (b) whether the Railways propose to provide medical facilities in all the trains and if so, the details thereof along with the number of trains in which medical facilities are available.
- (c) whether the Zonal Railways have been asked to appoint doctors and paramedics at Emergency Medical Rooms from its own funds to attend railway accident victims, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether it is also a fact that the Railways have decided to allow the Emergency Medical Rooms to be used as clinics by MBBS doctors or as chemist shops where chemists are likely to appoint trained paramedics and if so, the details thereof?
