- (c) whether the Government proposes to impart low cost training to the children through these unemployed youths on the lines of engineering colleges by preparing clusters; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof ?

- (a) & (b): To improve employability of its trainees, Government has introduced compulsory subject of employability skills for its Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) and Apprenticeship Training Scheme (ATS) and soft skills for Skill Development Initiative Scheme (SDIS).
- (c) & (d): There is no proposal to impart low cost training to the children through unemployed youths of I.T.I.s.
