- (a) to (c) Yes Madam, the Government proposes to develop rural clusters in the country under Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission(SPMRM), with the objective of improving the quality of life of the people in the cluster, bridging the rural urban divide and reducing migration from rural to urban areas. For 2015-16 budget estimate for SPMRM is Rs.300 crore.
- (d) Yes Madam. The Government had sought the views from the States on the draft scheme and based on the replies received, the relevant comments have been suitably incorporated in the EFC Note.
