## Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has started single connection for colony with hundred per cent subsidy for Below Poverty Line (BPL) families in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Chhattisgarh; and
- (c) the number of BPL families benefited by the scheme, State-wise?

## **Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR POWER, COAL & NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI PMUSH GOYAL)

(a)&(b): Under the erstwhile Rajiv Gandhi Grameen VidyutikaranYojana (RGGVY) now subsumed in DeendayalUpadhyaya Gram JyotiYojana (DDUGJY), Government is providing access to electricity to rural house-holds and providing free electricity connections to all BPL house-holds. As per the scheme BPL house- holds are provided free electricity connection with LED lamp at the rate of Rs.3000/- per connection in villages and habitations. Under the scheme, 921 projects have been sanctioned in the country covering release of free electricity connections to 3.96 crore BPL house-holds including Chhattisgarh. Cumulatively, as on 31.03.2015, free electricity connection to 2.18 crore BPL house-holds have been released.
