(b) if so, the details thereof during the last five years and the reasons attributed for the same;

(c) whether the Government has conducted investigations into such incidents;

(d) if so, the details along with the findings thereof;

(e) whether any steps or security measures have been taken to prevent such incidents in future; and

(f) if so, the details thereof?

(c)&(d) All cases were taken up by local police for investigation. Findings of police investigation are also indicated in the Annexure.

(f) Safety measures to prevent casualties due to industrial accidents are in place at all nuclear power plants. The security and safety instructions issued by various security agencies and the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board are strictly implemented at all nuclear power plant sites and residential townships. Awareness programmes regarding security threats and counter measures are being conducted on regular basis.
