- (a): The quantity of 57.98 lakh tons of wheat have been exported from Central Stocks through Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSUs) viz. Metals and Minerals Trading Corporations of India Limited (MMTC), The State Trading Corporation of India Limited (STC) and Projects & Equipment Corporation Limited (PEC) during the last three years. No direct export orders were received from any country.
- (b) Country-wise details of quantity and price of wheat exported during the last three years is given in Annexure-A.
