(a). There are 30 new sugar mills started in the country during last three sugar seasons (October- September). The State-wise details are as under:-

(b): The Central Government is providing loans at concessional rate of interest from Sugar Development Fund(SDF) to modernise existing mills. As such Entrepreneurs are free to set up new sugar mills at their preferred locations with free to access modern technology etc. subject to compliance of rules and regulations of the Central/State Government.

(c): The Government have received 129 proposals from entrepreneurs to set up sugar mills in the country are under implementation at various stages. The Statewise details of these proposals is at annexure.
