Representations from the State Government of Uttar Pradesh have been received inter- alia requesting for continuation of the raw sugar export incentive scheme for the current sugar season 2014-15. The Central Government has continued the incentive scheme for the current sugar season with an incentive of Rs. 4000 per MT for a quantity of 14 lakh MT, to be met from Sugar Development Fund.
