- (a): Yes, Madam. The Government has initiated a proposal for establishment of a Hastkala Academy at New Delhi in which research work on development of handicrafts will be undertaken.
- (b): The EFC has discussed the project at a cost of Rs.30.00 crores in its meeting on 13.02.2015. The draft minutes of the meeting are under submission.
- (c): The Government has been implementing the following seven generic schemes for making the handicraft competitive in the International Market:-
- (i) Baba Saheb Ambedkar Hastshilp Vikas Yojana (AHVY)
- (ii) Design and technology upgradation scheme
- (iii) Marketing support and services scheme
- (iv) Research and development scheme
- (v) Human and resource development scheme
