- iv) Market Linked Focus Product Scheme
- v) Market Access Initiative (MAI) Scheme.
- vi) Market Development Assistance (MDA) Scheme
- vii) Duty Drawback Scheme
- viii) Advance Licence Scheme
- ix) Duty-free import of trimmings, embellishments and other specified item under Export Performance Certificate Entitlement Scheme.
