- (c) whether the State Governments are required to release funds to Gram Panchayats for impleme- nting the rural drinking water projects under the recent budget restructuring; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) & (b) Yes Madam, Union Government under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) under the criteria for allocation of funds to State/UTs, 10% weightage has been given for "rural population managing rural drinking water supply schemes weighted by a Management Devo- lution Index (MDI)". This criterion for alloca- tion is used as incentive to States for decent- ralization and reforms in the sector and to encourage the States to hand over the rural water supply schemes to gram panchayats.
- (c) and (d) The guidelines regarding allocation of funds post budget restructuring are under preparation.
