- (a) the various training modules that are being prepared by the Ministry to scale up training so as to achieve one crore jobs in the country;
- (b) whether any State/UT-specific plan of action has been prepared for this purpose;
- (c) if so, the details thereof with parti- cular reference to Andhra Pradesh and Telangana; and
- (d) the present status of the said scheme?

(a) to (d): Four major schemes being run by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepre- neurship across the country are Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS), Apprenticeship Trai- ning Scheme (ATS), Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS) and Skill Development Initia- tive Scheme (SDIS) in Modular Employable Skills (MES) format. The number of courses in CTS, ATS, CITS and SDI are 126, 259, 34 and 578 respectively. The CTS courses are delivered through Industrial Training Ins- titutes (ITIs) which are under the administrative and financial control of State Governments or Union Territory Administ- rations. The ATS courses are delivered by Industrial establishments as per Apprenti- ceship Act, 1961. CITS courses are meant for training of Trainers & are delivered through field institutes and private Ins- titutes of Training of Trainers (ITOTs).
