- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. CGEWHO has completed 32 projects as per details given at Annexure-I
- (c) & (d): CGEWHO has conducted a demand survey in the year 2009. The substantial demands have been received in Chandigarh, Pune, Patna, Dehradun, Nagpur & Bangalore etc out of 20 surveyed stations. CGEWHO addresses housing shortage issues by providing housing to central government employees as per their demand, availability of land, feasibility of the project etc.
