(a) & (c) No incidents of large number of cases of alleged irregulation under the pension schemes of National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) have come to the notice of Government during the last three years and the current year. Identification of beneficiaries, sanction and disbursement of pension under the schemes is done by the State / UT Governments. The States Governments have already been directed to complete the digitization of data of all the beneficiaries under National Social Assistance Programme. Moreover, any grievances or complaints received in respect of implementation of schemes under NSAP are forwarded to the concerned State Governments for appropriate action.
