Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received proposals from the State Governments including State Government of Gujarat for the implementation and establishment of satellite township in their States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (c) the details of financial assistance sanctioned so far, in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Under the Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Satellite Towns around Seven Mega Cities (UIDSST), 7 towns namely, Pilkhuwa (U.P.), Vikarabad (Telangana), Sriperumbudur (Tamil Nadu), Sonepat (Haryana), Vasai-Virar (Maharashtra), Hoskote (Karnataka) including Sanand (Gujarat), have been covered. A total number of 17 projects are being implemented under the scheme with an approved cost of Rs.631.07 crore, of which Central share is Rs.500 crore. The total central assistance of Rs.325.79 crore has been released till 13.03.2015. Details of fund released, State-wise under the UIDSST scheme is at Annexure-I.
