- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Delhi Government thereto along with further action taken/likely to be taken in this regard?

(b) :A High Power Inter-Ministerial Committee constituted under the chairmanship of Secretary, Urban Development has deliberated on the matter and the Report is placed on Ministry of Urban Development website: [www.moud.gov.in](http://www.moud.gov.in) Major strategies recommended for decongestion of Delhi are:

1. Parking Pricing & Management;
2. Multimodal Integration;
3. Bicycle Sharing & Non-Motorized Transport (NMT) Infrastructure;
4. Road Retrofitting as per Street Design Guidelines;
5. Bus Service Improvements;
6. Bus Rapid Transit System (BRTS) Corridor Development;
7. Integrated Road Network;
8. Intelligent Transport System (ITS); and
9. Capacity Building Programmes.

(c & d): Officers from Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD) are included in the Committee and their proposals/recommendations have been considered in the preparation of the Report.
