(a): Yes, Madam. Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has furnished the details of acquired land in Narela, which are as under:

- (b) to (d): DDA has informed that it has prepared Zonal Development Plan of Narela sub-city (Zone P-1) having various use zones, namely, residential, commercial, industrial, transportation, utility, public and semi-public facilities, Government etc. to accommodate the projected population as provided in Master Plan of Delhi-2001. Based on the Zonal Plan, the detailed lay-out plans have been prepared and development is carried out in phased manner. The part road network at the site has already been executed and the land has been allotted to old age homes, night shelters, sports complex, working women hostels, etc.
- (e): DDA has informed that 11,309 flats are completed and the schedule for completion of 29,515, 7,402 and 11,597 flats is December, 2016, December, 2017 and June, 2018, respectively.
