Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether most of the cities in the country get water logged even with light rains on account of unscientific drainage system;

(b) If so, the steps taken to address the problem; and

(c) whether the Government has any nation-wide plan and budgetary provision for solving this problem in the cities and if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) to (c) : Many cities in the country experience water logging after moderate rainfall. This is a problem caused not only by unscientific drainage but also due to improper civic behavior leading to indiscriminate disposal of municipal solid waste into roadside drains and lack of regular desilting/ cleaning of drains.

Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) and State Governments draw up plans to tackle drainage problems as it is a State subject. However, the Ministry of Urban Development supplements the efforts of State Governments /ULBs for planning, design and construction of urban drainage system by issuing guidelines/advisories from time to time. Further a New Urban Rejuvenation Mission is being formulated in the Ministry which would provide access to States/ULBs for addressing this problem.
