- (b) the funds provided to these NGOs during each of the last three years and the current year?

(a) & (b): There is no scheme specifically meant for the Non-Government Organisations (NGO). However, under the Capacity Building for Urban Local Bodies (CBULB) Scheme of the Ministry, funds are provided to identified institutions including NGOs and States for addressing specific capacity gaps in the urban sector. Under the Scheme of Training Centres for Municipal Employees, funds are provided to the All India Institute of Local Self Government, (AllLSG) Mumbai which functions as the Ministry's Regional Centre for Urban and Environmental Studies at Mumbai. The details of funds provided to NGOs during the last three years and current year are at Annexure.
