THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING & URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) to (d): Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation in consultation with State Governments has appointed consultants for five states namely Assam, Andhra Pradesh, Sikkim, Telangana and West Bengal to formulate their respective State Urban Affordable Housing & Habitat Policy.

The main objective of the policy formulation is to create a road map for "affordable housing for all" with special emphasis on Economically Weaker Section (EWS), Low Income Group (LIG) and other vulnerable sections of society in order to achieve the objective of 'Housing for All' by 2022.
