- (b) Besides compensation, the following are provided to the family of deceased Army personnel:
- (i) Liberalised Family Pension.
 (ii) Death-cum-retirement Gratuity.
 (iii) Payment from Army Group Insurance Fund, Army Wives Welfare Association Fund and other benefits like Education Concession Card and Air Travel Concession Card are given.
 (iv) Provisions also exist for 'Instant Enrolment" in the Army in respect of one son / brother (if unmarried/married but without a male child) of the Battle Casualty, wherein the candidate is enrolled in the Army as a soldier if he is medically fit and in recruitable age.
