- (a) whether a number of complaints have been received against top scientists and officers heading various Laboratories / Establishments of Defence Research and Development Organisa- tion (DRDO) including Defence Materials and Stores Research and Development Establishment (DMSRDE);
- (b) if so, the details of such complaints re-ceived during the last three years Laboratory/ Establishment-wise, year-wise;
- (c) the details of fact finding committees set up during the above period along with their findings;
- (d) whether any action has been taken by the Government on these complaints or findings;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) the steps taken by the Government to stream- line the procedure of procurement and strict compliance of DRDOis procurement policy?

- (b) to (e): Information pertaining to complaints against heads of laboratories / establishments of DRDO received during the last 3 years and current year and other details, like fact finding committees, their findings and action taken on their recommendations, etc. is being collected.
- (f) DRDOs procurement is governed in accordance with the Procurement Manual (PM 2006) revised from time to time.

In addition, instructions have also been issued to the laboratories / establishments on Public Procurement Policy for MSEs; e-Publishing; and e-Procurement.
