Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has acquired land for defence project and many projects on the said land have not been started so far;
- (b) if so, the number of projects out of the above on which work has not been started so far and the area of land which is lying unused so far:
- (c) whether the Government proposes to return the said land to the farmers for cultivation;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI MANOHAR PARRIKAR)

(a) to (e): Acquisition of defence land is done for specific operational and infrastructural requirement of Armed Forces and defence Estab-lishments based on defined land norms after a proper assessment of necessity. However, the projects in different land parcels are under-taken in a phased manner taking into conside-ration operational priority and availability of funds. As acquired Defence land is earma-rked for use of Defence Forces there is no proposal for return of any acquired land.
