- (b) To support higher technical and professional education of dependent wards / widows of ex-servi- cemen and ex-Indian Coast Guards, the Prime Mini- sters Scholarship Scheme was introduced in the year 2006. 4000 scholarships are awarded annually under the scheme to the wards of Ex-servicemen/ widows. The scheme is funded out of National De- fence Fund The amount of scholarship is Rs.2000/- per month for boys and Rs.2250/- per month for girls.
- (c) The State / UT-wise number of wards of ex- servicemen, martyrs of the Armed Forces and ex- Coast Guard granted scholarships including Madhya Pradesh during 2014-15 is at Annexure.
