- (b) if so, the details thereof and the amount allocated to the State Government for the purpose; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c) The Government has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 119.07 crore for acquisition of 135 feet wide land for a distance of 179 km along the Inte- rnational border with Pakistan under the opera- tional control of Border Security Force (BSF). This 135 feet wide land includes land acquired for fencing purpose. During the year 2014-15, an amount of Rs. 12.12 crore has been released to State Government on the basis of the progress of land acquisition by the State Government.
