(a) & (b) 'Police' is a State subject as per the VIIth Schedule in the Constitution of India. Thus, the primary responsibility for managing the State Police and setting up of police station lies with the State Governments.

Modernization of Police Force (MPF) Scheme is an important initiative of the Government of India to strengthen the police infrastructure. Ministry of Home Affairs provides funds for police stations in specific areas such as Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected area, etc., from time to time.
