Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a large number of decaying bodies have been found in the Ganga river in Unnao district of Uttar Pradesh,if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto:
- (b) whether human skeletons/body parts and viscera were also reportedly found dumped in a locked room of the Reserve Police lines in Unnao, Uttar Pradesh and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the body parts including skulls of unide- ntified bodies were reportedly kept for investigation, if so, the details thereof and the reasons for not disposing of the mortal remains/body parts after completion of investigation in the matter;
- (d) whether the Government has any guidelines for disposal of human remains/body parts of unidentified bodies, if so, the details thereof and if not, the steps taken/being taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (e) whether DNA samples of these skeletons and viscera were taken and kept safe for identification, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e): Yes Madam. A total number of 81 bodies have been recovered by the State Government of Uttar Pradesh and after attending to the formalities of the DNA ana-lysis etc., these bodies were disposed off after performing the last rituals. Further, Health being a State subject, the State Government is responsible for dis-posal of human remains/body parts of unidentified bodies.
