- (a) to (b): As per the information available, the Indian coast Guard (ICG), coastal Police and Fisheries Departments are organizing security awareness programme for fishermen. They are being briefed about security concerns and advised to inform security agencies if they notice any suspicious activity or presence of a suspicious vessel/boat at the sea. During awareness programmes, the fishermen are also advised to carry their identity documents, boat documents and safety equipments while venturing into sea.
