- (a) whether the Government has any record regarding the freedom fighters hailing from the North Eastern region of the country;
- (b) if so, whether it is a fact that their names are not familiar to the rest of the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has any proposal to include the history of the freedom fighters from the North Eastern Region in the curriculum of the students; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

## **Answer**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RUJJU)

- (a): Ministry of Home Affairs grants Swatantrata Sainik Samman Pension to those freedom fighters and their eligible dependents(as also of martyrs) who fulfill the eligibility criteria and eviden- tiary requirements laid down in the Swatantrata Sainik Samman Pension Scheme, 1980. Since incep- tion of the Scheme, 5484 freedom fighters/eligible dependents from North Eastern Region have been granted Central Samman Pension and at present 1384 are living and drawing the pension.
- (b) to (e): National Council of Educational Research and Training(NCERT) has reported that the present history curriculum does not have specific region- wise coverage of the history of freedom fighters as it has been developed based on a thematic app- roach to promote "conceptual understanding" of history among students as per National Curriculum Framework- 2005.
