- (a)& (b) Government has no such proposal to limit the number of vehicles in the country as a measure to combat climate change.
- (c)& (d) Developed country like Germany has imposed CO₂ oriented vehicle tax and carbon dioxide limits for car. Car ownership in Singapore is discouraged through imposing additional registration fee and Certificate of Entitlement (CoE) system to limit the number of vehicles registered.
