(a)& (b) India coordinates with the Group of 77 and China, BASIC (Brazil, South Africa, India and China)countries and Like Minded Developing Countries (LMDC) in respect of climate change negotiations under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). India also coordinates with the member countries of South Asian Association of Regional Cooperation (SAARC) and Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) on technical cooperation on various issues of climate change.
