- (a) & (b) It is the responsibility of the State Governments and its concerned agencies to conserve water bodies, including ponds and step wells within their jurisdiction and ensure that their encroachment does not take place.
- (c) & (d) While due to anthropogenic pressures, the water bodies are getting stressed, however, no specific assessment has been made of its estimated impact on these water bodies.
