- (a) India has not made any contributions to the UNFCCC's GreenClimate Fund.
- (b) and (c): Government has constituted following funds to implement climate change strategies:
- 1) A 'National Adaptation Fund' with an initial corpus of Rs. 100 Crore has been setup to support adaptation actions to combat thechallenges of climate change.
- 2) National Clean Energy Fund (NCEF): the fund is being fed by a cess on coal. The objective of the fund is to finance clean environment initiatives and to fund research in the area of clean environment.
