(a) to (c) Government of India proposes to set up a National Institute for Climate Change Studies and Actions (NICCSA) during the 12th Plan period under the Climate Change Action Programme (CCAP) of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change with the objective of coordinating all activities and analytical studies on scientific, environmental, economic and technological issues related to climate change.
