- (a) & (b): Yes Madam. The Government has extended the permission for providing prepaid mobile phone services in Jammu and Kashmir, Assam and North East Service Areas for a period of two years w.e.f. 01.04.2015 as per the instructions dated 31.03.2015 issued by Govt. of India, Department of Telecommunications.
- (c) to (f): No Madam, the pre-paid mobile services in Jammu & Kashmir, Assam and North East service areas have been extended as per the existing guidelines issued by the Department of Telecommunications on 20.01.2010 for the verification and issue of mobile connections.
