REPORT ON INTERNAL SECURITY
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Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government had commissioned a study on the Internal Security situation in the country in 2006;
- (b) whether as per the report of the said study, the problem of naxalism has taken the entire country in its grip;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the main findings therein;
- (d) whether all the recommendations made in the report have been implemented and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to conduct a study to find out the present status of internal security in the country and if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a) to (d) As per available information, no such study was conducted by the Ministry of Home Affairs during 2006. However, the Planning Commission had constituted a Working Group on 'Land Relations for Formulation of 11th Five Year Plan" under the Chairmanship of Shri D. Bandyopadhyay, which had made a number of recommendations which were pertinent in the context of Left Wing Extremism problem in the country. Some of those recommendations resulted in policy formulations in different Ministries/Departments of Government of India. But it was not a specific study on Internal Security situation of the Country.
- (e) The Government constantly gets feedback on internal security situation from its agencies and there is no specific proposal to conduct a separate study by an outside agency/body.
