(a) to (e): Department of Personnel & Training issued OM No.1/3/2008-Estt (Pay-I) dated 14th/28th April, 2009 followed by reminders to all the Ministries/Departments requesting them to furnish their considered views/suggestions regarding addition/deletion of qualifications listed in the Annexure to the OM No.1/2/89- Estt.(Pay-1) dated 9th April, 1999 for consideration of the Centralized Committee. Only few Ministries/Departments have sent in their suggestions. In order to consider addition of as many new qualifications as possible, all the Secretaries to the Government of India have again been reminded in this regard on 8.4.2015.
