(a) & (b) A programme namely 'Civic Action Programme' has been formulated by the Government for welfare of border population. The broad items included in this programme are carrying out repair to community buildings, medical/veterinary facilities, study tour/excursion programmes for rural youth, imparting vocational training, initiation of cottage industries, improvement of roads/tracks, sanitation & hygiene, assistance during natural calamities, water harvesting, sports facilities/sports competitions and pre-recruitment training in the border areas.

Civic Action Programme is implemented by the Border Guarding Forces. This facilitates cordial relations of security forces with the local populace. By the active participation, local people are motivated and become conscious about the national security.
