## Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether incidents of crime against women police officials/ officers while on duty have been reported in the country;
- (b) if so, the total number of such cases registered, guilty arrested and the action taken against them along with the cases solved/ unsolved and the steps taken to solve all the cases during each of the lastthree years and the current year, State and crime-wise including molestation, eve teasing and sexual assault; and
- (c) the safety precautions put in place to protect women personnel while on duty along with the other measures taken by the Government to stop such cases in future?

## **Answer**

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Home Affairs do not have data on crime against women police officers while on duty.

As per Seventh Schedule to the Constitution of India, 'Police' is a State subject hence it is primarily the responsibility of States to evaluate on these matters. The Central Government has no role in this regard.
