(a) to (d): The "Power Sector Diagnostic Review" was undertaken by the World Bank's South Asia Energy Team at the request of Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance. In this Report, the World Bank team has mainly suggested various reforms in the distribution segment. The Government has already taken various initiatives to bring about reforms in this sector, including the launch of two new schemes of 'Deendayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana' and 'Integrated Power Development Scheme'. Meetings with the States to firm up strategy for reforms in power sector are a continuous process.
