STATEMENT TO BE LAID ON THE TABLE OF THE HOUSE IN RESPECT OF PARTS (a) to (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 402 ADMI- TTED FOR REPLY ON 22.04.2015 REGARDING "PRADHAN MANTRI KAUSHAL VIKAS YOJANA"

- (a) The Union Cabinet has approved the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) with an outlay of Rs 1500 crore for skill development covering 24 lakh persons. PMKVY focus on skill training of first time entrants to the labour market and recognition of prior learning. It is a demand driven skill training programme based on skill gap studies and provides for skill training as per the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) and industry led standards.
- (b) The scheme provides for monetary reward to trainees on assessment and certification by third party assessment bodies. The details are given below:

(c) & (d) The Scheme has provision for Skill Development Management System (SDMS) to verify and record details of all training centres, locations and courses as well as a robust grievance redressal system to address grievances relating to implementation of the scheme. A Skill Development Management System (SDMS) is already operational for complete online implementation of the scheme. The existing feature includes capturing of complete information of candidates, training providers, training centres, and capturing

process related details such enrolment, training, assessment, result, certification and bank details for reward money disbursement. Moreover, an online grievances redressal system alongwith detailed consequences management system is developed for scheme implementation. It is envisaged to link the grievances system with the existing SDMS and call centre for effective and timely redressal of the same.
