(a) The Government has been supporting the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) in its skilling activities /programmes. NSDC has been implementing various skilling programmes of the Central Government including STAR (Standard, Training, Assessment and Reward) Scheme for skilling youth from across the country and UDAAN Scheme for youth from Jammu & Kashmir.
