Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of total arable land on which contract farming is being carried out in the country;
- (b) the names of the Multi-National and Indian Companies engaged in contract farming in the country;
- (c) the total amount of loan/financial assistance provided to each company by the public sector banks and financial institutions during each of the last three years;
- (d) whether the farmers of the country are benefited by contract farming; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MOHANBHAI KUNDARIA)

- (a): Contract farming is reportedly being carried out in about 29,824 hectares which is about 0.016% of total arable land in the country.
- (b): As per available information, the Multi-National and Indian Companies engaged in contact farming in the country are as at Annexure.
- (c): This information is not available as it is not being maintained by the concerned State Departments.
- (d) & (e): The farmers of the country are reportedly being bene- fited by contract farming as the contracting companies provide quality inputs (seed, fertilizer, etc) and technology to the farmers to grow crops and also provide buy-back facility to purchase the contracted produce at predetermined prices.
