(a) & (b): All Central government Plan schemes like National Food Security Mission (NFSM), National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP), Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH), etc. and State Plan schemes are being implemented for development of agriculture in all maoist influenced districts of the state.

The interventions like notified hybrid seed scheme, System of Rice Intensification (SRI) scheme, Fallow Land scheme, Construction of godowns are being implemented.

(c) & (d): Yes, Madam. Pulses like arhar, uradbean, moongbean, gram, oilseeds like niger, linseed, sesamum, rapeseed & mustard, vegetable like potato, onion, tomato and medicinal plants like safed musli, aloevera, lemon grass are being cultivated in maoist influenced areas of Jharkhand.
