- (a) whether lac is produced from Palash trees in Banka region of Bihar, hilly and arid-humidity region;
- (b)if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has proposed to set up Agricultural Research Centres for betterment and training of the farmers and workers engaged in lac production and for conservation of Palash trees; and
- (d) if so, the time by which the research centres are likely to be set up?

Answer

- (a) & (b): Lac production from Palash trees is being undertaken informally by local people in Banka region of Bihar.
- (c) & (d): Government of India has established a Network Project on 'Conservation of Lac Insect Genetic Resources (NP-CLIGR)' with lead Centre at Indian Institute of Natural Resins & Gums (IINRG), Ranchi and eight other Network Cooperating Centres in different State Agricultural Universities/Research Institutions, the details of which are given in Annexure.
