(a) & (b): No assessment has been made regarding the potential of palm plantation including coconut and toddy for creating jobs and generating revenue in the country.

(c): Coconut Development Board, Government of India has taken following steps for promoting use of modern technology for better cultivation, storage and marketing of coconut water and neera:

(i) production and distribution of quality planting materials;

(ii) expansion of area under coconut with high yielding varieties;

(iii) integrated farming for productivity improvement;

(iv) replanting and rejuvenation of coconut gardens;

(v) technologies for processing and packaging;

(vi) establishing processing units for commercial production;

(vii) thematic promotion of tender coconut and neera through print and electronic media.
