(a): For holistic development of the bamboo sector in the country Government of India has been implementing, since 2006-07, a Centrally Sponsored Scheme titled "National Bamboo Mission" which is a sub-scheme of Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture in all the States except Haryana. The objectives of the mission are to promote growth of the bamboo sector through the area based regionally differentiated strategies, improve productivity, create employment opportunities for skilled and unskilled persons etc. To achieve these objectives, financial assistance is provided to States for development of bamboo related activities like Research and Development, establishment of high-tech nurseries, rehabilitation of tissue culture units, area expansion, improvement of existing stock, technology transfer and human resource development, creation of water resources, integrated post harvest management, innovative intervention, establishment of marketing infrastructure etc.
